# TEXAS BOARD OF VETERINARY MEDICAL EXAMINERS BOARD MEETING MINUTES January 28, 2020

The Texas Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners met for a scheduled meeting on Tuesday, January 28, 2020 at 10:00 a.m. in Room #2-225 of the William P. Hobby, Jr. Building, 333 Guadalupe, Austin, Travis County, Texas.

#### Agenda Item 1. Full Board Call to Order, Roll Call.

Jessica Quillivan, DVM, Board President, called the meeting to order at 10:01 a.m. Board Members present were Jessica Quillivan; Mr. Keith Pardue, Vice President; Lynn Criner, DVM, Secretary; Carlos Chacon; Samantha Mixon, DVM; Michael White, DVM; and Sue Allen, LVT. Board Staff present were: Executive Director, John Helenberg, Operations Director Candice Simon; General Counsel, Brittany Sharkey; Enforcement Supervisor, Mike Tacker; and Compliance Investigator Jerod Honrath. Board Members absent were Randy Skaggs, DVM. Board Staff absent Patricia Prentice, Executive Assistant.

#### Agenda Item 2. Consideration and Approval of the October 15, 2019 Minutes.

Dr. Criner moved to accept the October 15th, 2019 minutes, Dr. White seconded, and the motion passed unanimously to approved.

### Agenda Item 3. Executive Director's Report.

Mr. Helenberg reported Patricia Prentice was absent due to loss in her family. In staffing updates, Ms. Leticia Kappel has taken on the role of interim CFO and helps with the agency's finance needs. She is also the Deputy Executive Director of the Dental Board and will be working for TBVME part-time. Catherine Torres has been hired as the Staff Services Officer and will assist Ms. Kappel with finance duties and also manage human resources issues for the agency. Mary Blenis is now a certified purchaser for the agency after having completed the requisite courses. Additionally, the Agency has posted a job opening for a paralegal. There is an AAVSB training for Board Members in April and it is recommended for any Board member that has not already attended the training. Review by the Sunset Commission of the Agency is set to take place in July and August of this year and public testimony on the agency will be heard at that Capitol on December 10 and 11. The new legislative requirement for controlled substances continuing education will be required to be completed by licensees by their license renewals in 2022. The agency is planning on conducting strategic planning meetings around the state, preliminary dates and locations are March 10<sup>th</sup> in El Paso, March 11<sup>th</sup> in Amarillo and March 12<sup>th</sup> in Arlington. Current statistics for the agency include: 32% of the annual budget has been utilized and we are 36% of the way through the year. 839 licenses have been renewed and we currently have 8599 licensed veterinarians, 1700 licensed veterinary technicians and 58 licensed equine dental providers. Enforcement brought in 99 cases and cleared 100. The legal division currently has 201 open cases. The Executive Team continues to meet with the Texas Facilities Commission about the agency's move to the George W Bush building in 2022. Rule approvals have been slightly delayed due to staffing changes in the Governor's Office.

## Agenda Item 4. Discussion, recommendation and possible action regarding adoption of rule changes to be published in the Texas Register.

a. 571.15 Temporary License Program (Amendment)

Ms. Sharkey presented an overview of the proposed temporary license program. Amending the rule to read:

- (2) A temporary veterinary license is valid for 60 days. The 60-day period does not have to run consecutively. A temporary veterinary license may not be renewed or reissued. A person may not be issued more than two temporary veterinary licenses in a calendar year.
- Dr. Quillivan expressed concern that the duration of a year might be too long. Dr. Criner questioned the oversight of the temporary licensees to ensure that rules are being followed. Ms. Sharkey provided that under the current rules all temporary licenses work under the general supervision of a fully licensed Texas veterinarian and that veterinarian would be held liable for any complaints generated by the temporary licensee. The board discussed changing the duration of the temporary license to six months rather than a year.

Mr. Pardue made a motion to adopt the proposed Temporary License Program with the discussed changes, Dr. Mixon seconded the motion and the motion was passed. Dr. White was opposed.


