Current **Texas Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners** policy regarding veterinary technicians:

As long as a graduate of an AVMA accredited veterinary technician school takes and passes the TVMA (Texas Veterinary Medical Association) administered State Exam in June 2014, receives a passing score on the July/August VTNE, and has met all requirements to become an RVT with TVMA prior to August 31, 2014, the State Board will allow such individuals to be grandfathered – even if the individual's July/August VTNE score is not received until after the August 31st grandfathering deadline.
