

Policy Regarding Disciplinary Actions Reported On the Texas Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners Website and Reported to the American Association of Veterinary State Boards (AAVSB)

It is the policy of the Texas Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners (“TBVME”) that disciplinary orders in which a licensee was formally reprimanded, suspended, revoked, a combination of one or more of these actions, or a combination of one or more of these actions and a lesser (non-reportable) action will be reported on the agency website and reported to the AAVSB. These actions may be referred to as “reportable” actions.

It is further the policy of the TBVME that disciplinary orders in which a licensee was informally reprimanded, received an administrative penalty, was required to pay restitution, or a combination of one or more of these actions will not be reported on the agency website, nor will they be reported to the AAVSB. These actions may be referred to as “non-reportable” actions.

Upon receipt of a Public Information Request a copy of any disciplinary order, whether it is considered to be reportable or non-reportable as set forth above, will be released to the requestor.
