Code §573.43</p>	<p>Dismissal for voluntary compliance or \$500 - \$3,000 administrative penalty</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Length of time licensee has been in violation of registration requirement</li> <li>- Prior violations of a similar nature</li> <li>- Co-operation with Board investigators</li> <li>- Evidence of criminal conduct</li> <li>- Evidence of voluntary compliance</li> <li>- Whether licensee was administering and dispensing controlled substances under the direct, continuous, and active oversight of a DEA-registered veterinarian</li> </ul>
